REQUIRED:

- EMST (Emergency Management of Severe Trauma)
- ADAPT
- Major Australasian ICM conference e.g. CICM single theme meeting, (if trainee not presenting their formal project) once yearly at ICM VTC discretion. (Letter of support required).
- Any Australasian ICM/Anaesthetic/Emergency Medicine conference where the trainee is presenting their formal project in order to complete their CICM formal project module
- One Cardiac Echo course during FCICM training
- One Ultrasound Course during FCICM training
- One Emergency Airway skills course during FCICM training
- BASIC course

RECOMMENDED:

Senior Intensive Care Trainees should attend at least two from:

- Australian Short Course IC Medicine (Adelaide) (1 week)
- ANZICS Intensive Care Reg Course (Melbourne) (2-3 days)
- Australian Intensive Care Clinical Refresher Course (Brisbane) (2-3 days)
- ANZICS/CICM NZ Intensive Care Registrar's course (2-3 days)"
- Canberra ICU course (Canberra) (3 days)
